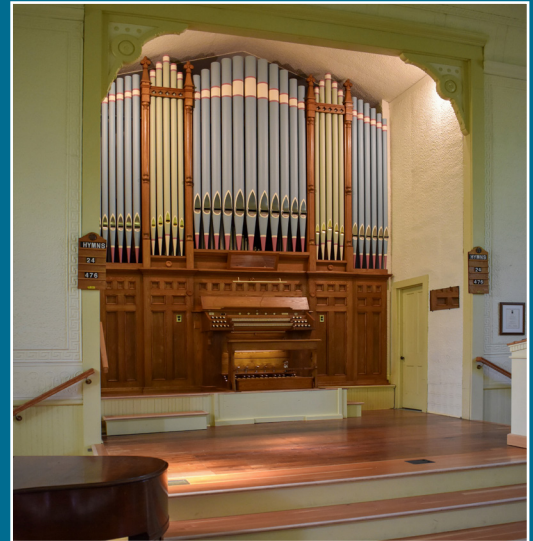

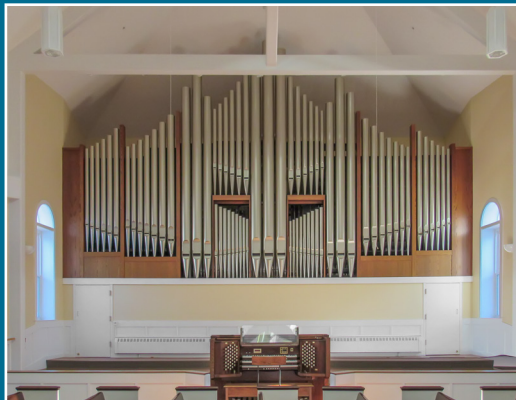

## ON THE BACK COVER

### CHRIST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH, U.C.C. BROCKTON, MASSACHUSETTS

*The 1995 Austin organ built for this new structure was installed with a prepared-for Choir division. On April 30, 2021, Messrs. Czelusniak et Dugal, Inc. completed the installation of the Choir in its intended place behind the two left-most flats of the façade. The windchest, action, and wind regulation parts were custom made by Austin Organs, Inc., Hartford. The installation and tonal finishing were executed by C&D, Inc., along with construction of the expression structure, and the pipework preparation, racking, and voicing. The new division consists of 11 ranks on Austin patent pneumatic action, Tremulant, Chimes, and Zimbelstern. The finished instrument now comprises 39 ranks.*

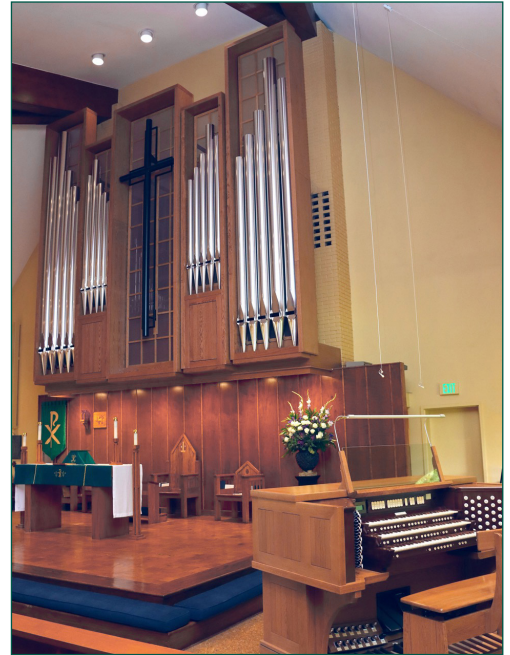

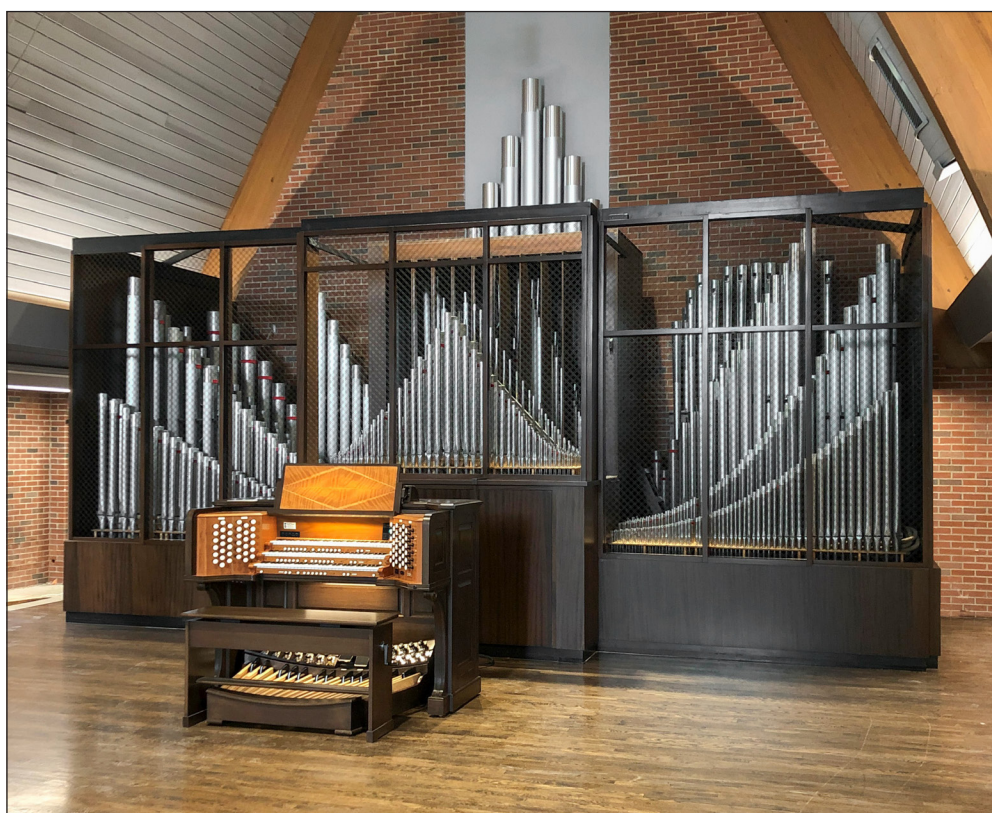

Czelusniak et Dugal, Inc. were commissioned for substantial releathering restoration of the same instrument, encompassing the large wind reservoir, all pneumatic switching in the console, and some lesser repair work, all completed successfully on March 26, 2021.*

*A 1985 French-style Schlicker unit organ was purchased by the church to replace their first organ, a 1925 Austin "Corophone", intended to become the core of Rosales Organ Builders, Opus 41. Six ranks, one windchest and the console shell were retained, augmented with 12 enclosed ranks, a new facade of Stinkens pipes designed by S. Morris Barth-Wise to echo the Corophone's facade, and two unenclosed principal ranks. The Harris Precision tilting tablets are engraved in both English and Hawaiian. The feature-laden Opus Two operating system includes an easily edited Piston Sequencer.*

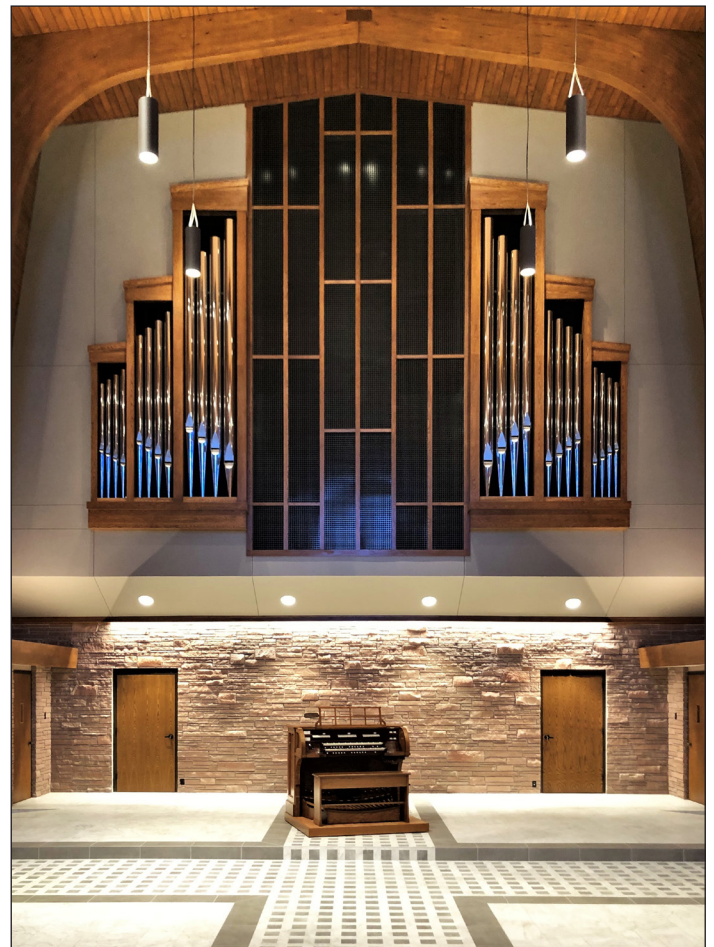

*Originally built for Independent Presbyterian Church, Savannah, Georgia, it was removed to storage and sold to First Scots Presbyterian Church, Beaufort, South Carolina, but was never installed. Upon being sold to St John's, the organ was brought to the P-H shop for restoration where they replaced all the slider seals, fiber pull-downs, re-packed stoppers and caps, bushed the pedalboard, restored the swimmer, repaired the sponsils, and replaced the aluminum trackers as needed.*

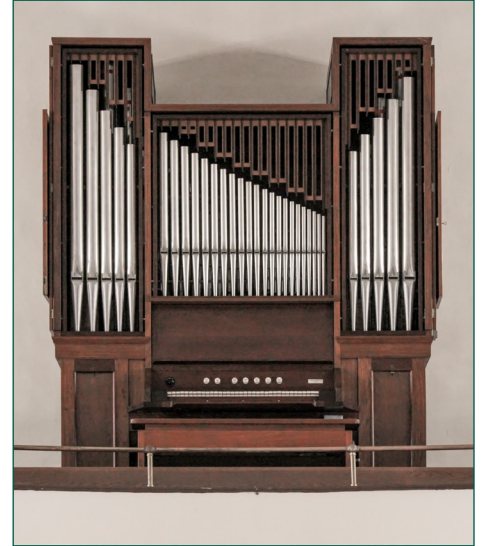

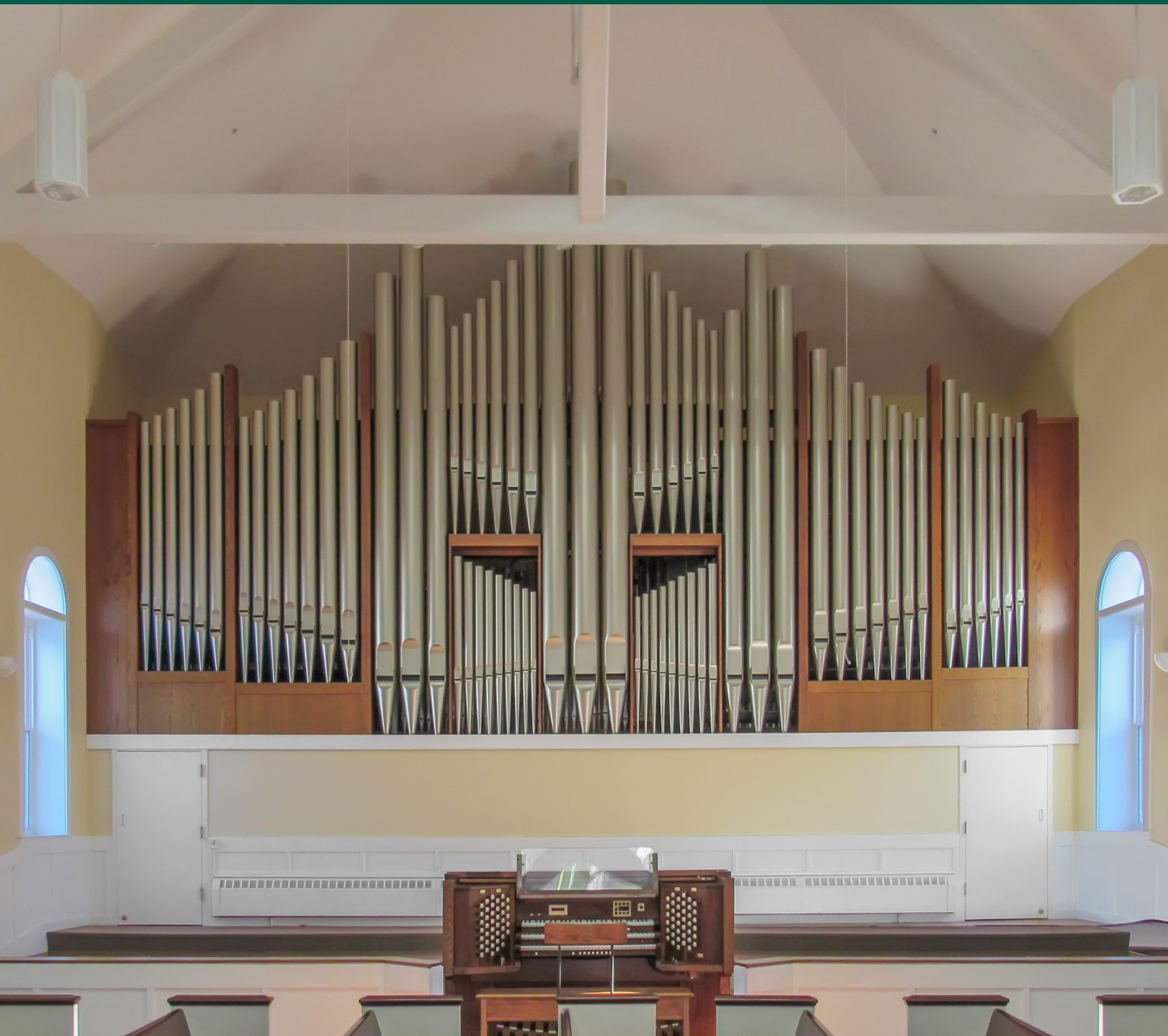
