Borrowing from a Moller Pitman Chest II

When drilling out the exhaust hole through the topboard for desired notes, use a drill size that is the correct diameter for a piece of brass tubing to run from the surface inside to about 1/2" above the top outside. This 1/2" protrusion on the outside becomes the nipple for your exterior tubing. Also, by having the tubing through the entire bore of the topboard, you effectively seal off the old action channel reducing any problems between old and new action. I've done it and it works great!
